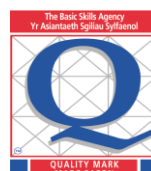

Friday, Sept. 11th:

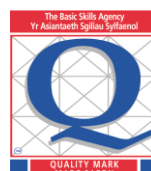
8:45am-3:10pm: All pupils to return to school.

- No lunch will be provided during the first two weeks of September, therefore you will need to provide your child with a healthy packed lunch and a bottle of water please.
- The Breakfast Club will re-open on September 7th for pupil supervision only and will open for supervision and breakfast for pupils as of September 14th. I will update you with more information once it becomes available.
- Menter Cwm Gwendraeth will re-open Bydis Brynsierfel after-school club on September 14th and I will update you with more information in due course.
- Please note that in line with Welsh Government guidelines, **no parents or visitors can enter the school building at this time**. Due to the continued serious risks surrounding the Coronavirus, the strict health and safety rules will continue in September. Please see attached another copy of the **Home School Agreement** which must be signed by yourself and your child prior to his/her return to school. **By signing this document you are agreeing to abide by the rules.**
- In order to avoid queuing on the rear yard one way system, specific arrival and collection times have been allocated to each year group. **Please ensure that you adhere to these allocated time slots on each visit to ensure the safety of all.**
- All pupils must be escorted by **one parent or responsible adult** to the rear of the classroom to complete a daily health risk assessment **on every occasion they attend school.**

- A member of staff will greet you at the rear gate of the school upon arrival. There is clear marcation on the yard outside each classroom to ensure a 2 metre distance. You are kindly asked to queue on these marks until a member of staff has received your child and follow the one-way system.

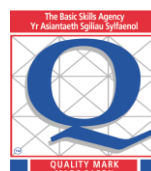
